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The first five minutes

CHECK-OUT

Ask your host

- Double-check closets and drawers for personal belongings

IN AN EMERGENCY

In case of a fire, medical issue, or any immediate danger, call 911 right away. For anything urgent about the property itself, contact your host as soon as you can so they can help you sort it out.

Check-in

Your host will send over the specific arrival details ahead of your stay. Once you know your arrival window, reach out to your host directly if you have any questions about getting inside.

WiFi

Your host will provide the network name and password on arrival. If the signal drops during your stay, try restarting the router, and reach out to your host if the connection doesn't come back.

03

House rules

Please treat Sea View Cottage with care and respect it as you would your own home. Keep noise levels reasonable, especially in the evening, out of consideration for neighbors nearby. If you have guests over or plan anything out of the ordinary, check with your host first.

Amenities

Sea View Cottage is stocked with the everyday comforts you need for a relaxed stay. Take a look around when you arrive to see what's on hand, and reach out to your host if you're looking for something specific.

Quirks of the home

Every stay has a few small things that take a moment to figure out. If something in the space seems unusual or you're not sure how it works, just ask your host and they'll walk you through it.

Getting here

Sea View Cottage is located at 123 Ocean Ave in Miami, FL. Plug the address into your preferred map app to get turn-by-turn directions, and reach out to your host if you run into any trouble finding the place.

Parking

Your host can point you to the best place to park once you arrive. If you have any questions about parking before your stay, feel free to ask ahead of time.

Getting around

Miami offers a mix of ways to get around, including rideshare services, taxis, and public transit. Having a car can make it easier to explore at your own pace, but it's not the only way to see the area.

Groceries

You'll find grocery stores throughout the Miami area for stocking up on essentials during your stay. A quick search on your map app will point you to the closest option.

Is there anything nearby for groceries or food?

Miami has grocery stores throughout the area, and a quick map search will show you the nearest options.
